<u>1. Introduction</u>

Warm greetings to you in the Mighty and Matchless Name of our Lord Jesus Christ. We thank God for bringing us to the endof the year; we are thankful to the Almighty for the successful third term we have had.

2. Growth and Development

a) Enrolment: We are closing the year with an enrolment of **222** (Two hundred twenty-one) students (68 in Kindergarten, 77 in Elementary – Grades 1 to 6, and 77 in Senior school – Grades 7 to 12).

Out of the total enrolment, 20 (twenty) students are in the Kasanje (Boarding) Campus, while 18 (eighteen) are on the home-school arrangement, and we continue to support them accordingly.

b) Parent Fellowship/ **Seminars:** The school held two successful Parents Fellowship/ Seminars on 01st October and 04th November 2023, with interesting engaging topics and warm fellowship.

c) **Promotion and Graduations:** A number of students were promoted to different levels. We celebrate the progress of the students and pledge to continue supporting all in their various academic and growth needs. We have also had some finish and graduate at different levels of the ICCE certificates and GED exit option.

Five (5) students have so far received their General Education Diploma (GED) certificates, and 4 will be completing their courses soon.

<u>3. Shoma Expansion</u>

The newly started Boarding Campus at Kasanje had an eventful first year of operations with students getting involved in sports, community mission outreach, farming practicals, mentorship and discipleship classes – all these as part of their wholistic growth and development. Their academic work also progressed will, and the new staff have continued getting better acquainted with the curriculum and school details. The campus hosts Elementary and Senior Students of 10 years and above.

The school received a warm reception in the community. Physical infrastructure development continues at this campus and we look forward to more growth.

5. EASC (East Africa Student Convention)

In 2023, fifty-one (51) of our students successfully participated in the Uganda National Student Convention (UNSC), which took place from o8th to 12th May 2023, at Viva College – Jinja (Residential). They participated in performance and non- performance activities and won 33 medals; in a range of Gold, silver and bronze. We appreciate all parents who prayed and supported their children to attend this convention.

For 2024, this event has now transformed into the East Africa Student Convention (EASC), and

will take place in August 2023 in Turi, Kenya. Details will be communicated in due course. We encourage parents of students of 12 years and above to prepare for this event.

6. School Fees:

Fees Payment Policy: We appreciate all those who clear the school fees in time in accordance with our guidelines. In order to run the school smoothly, we hereby remind you that adhering to the school fees payment policy is a must for all.
