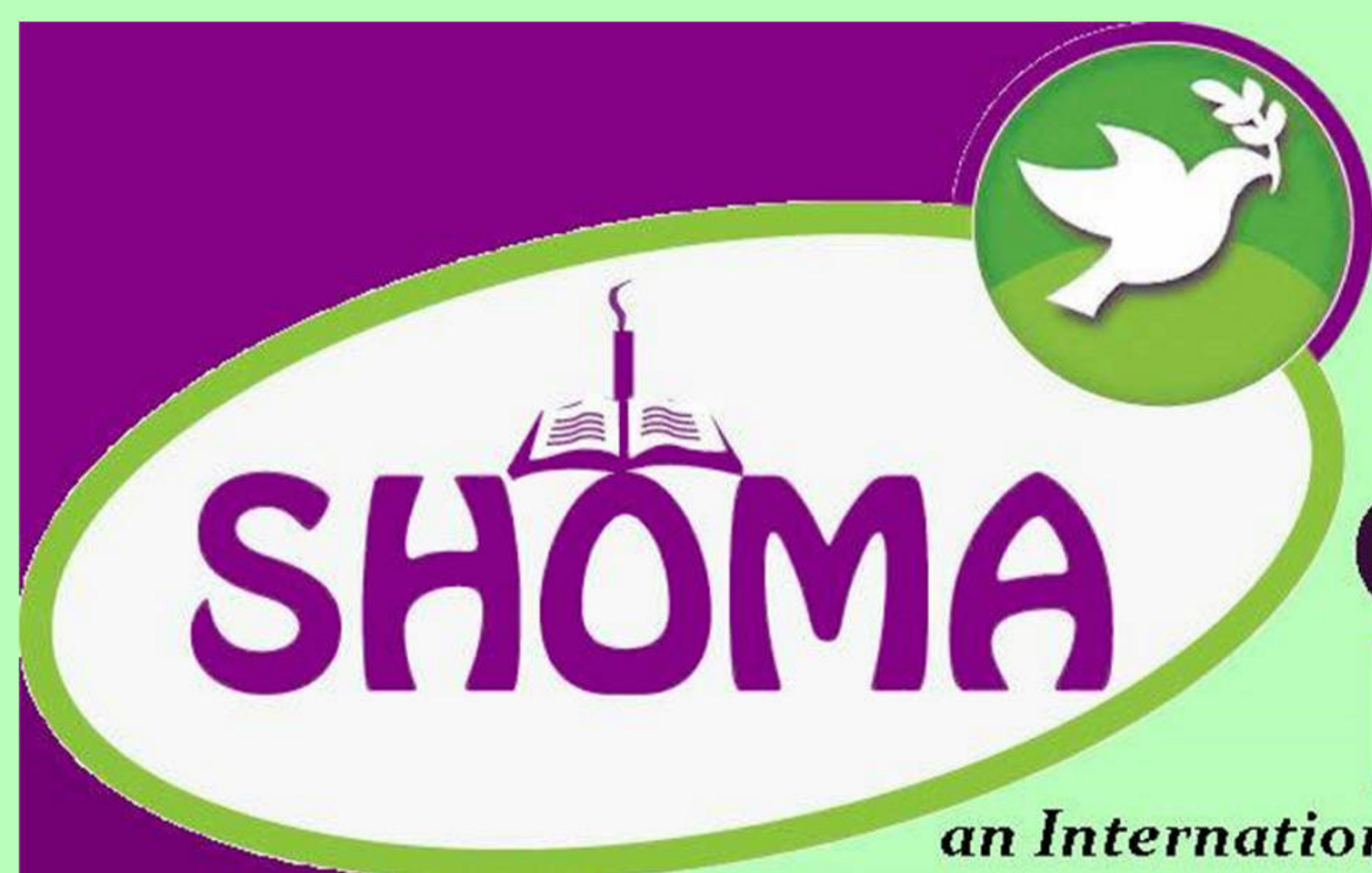

1. Introduction

Warm greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ! We thank God for His faithfulness in guiding us through a successful First Term, anchored on the theme *“Proclaiming God’s Goodness” (Deuteronomy 32:3)*. This theme encouraged our school community to reflect God’s goodness through character, conduct, and excellence in all areas of life.

2. Growth and Development

a) Enrollment: We close this term with a total enrollment of 240 (Two Hundred Forty) Students. Of these, 189 students are at Ntinda Campus; 44 Kindergarten, 69 Elementary (Grades 1–6), 76 Senior School (Grades 7–12). 51 students are at Kasanje Campus We still have vacancies for students at all levels and you are welcome to enroll with us.

b) Parent Fellowship/ Seminars: We successfully hosted a *Parent Fellowship / Seminar on 11th April 2026*, featuring an engaging topic “Orientation to ACE and Enhancing Effective Communication Between Parent and Children” with a warm atmosphere of interaction and learning. We are sincerely thankful to all parents and guardians who attended and contributed to the success of this event.

c) Promotion and Graduations: Eleven (11) students graduated from our High School and the graduation ceremony was held on 20th February, Several students were also promoted to new academic levels with some already in the final stages of completing their programs under the *ICCE Certification* and *GED Exit Option*, We are proud of their hard work, perseverance, progress, and eagerly look forward to celebrating their achievements soon.

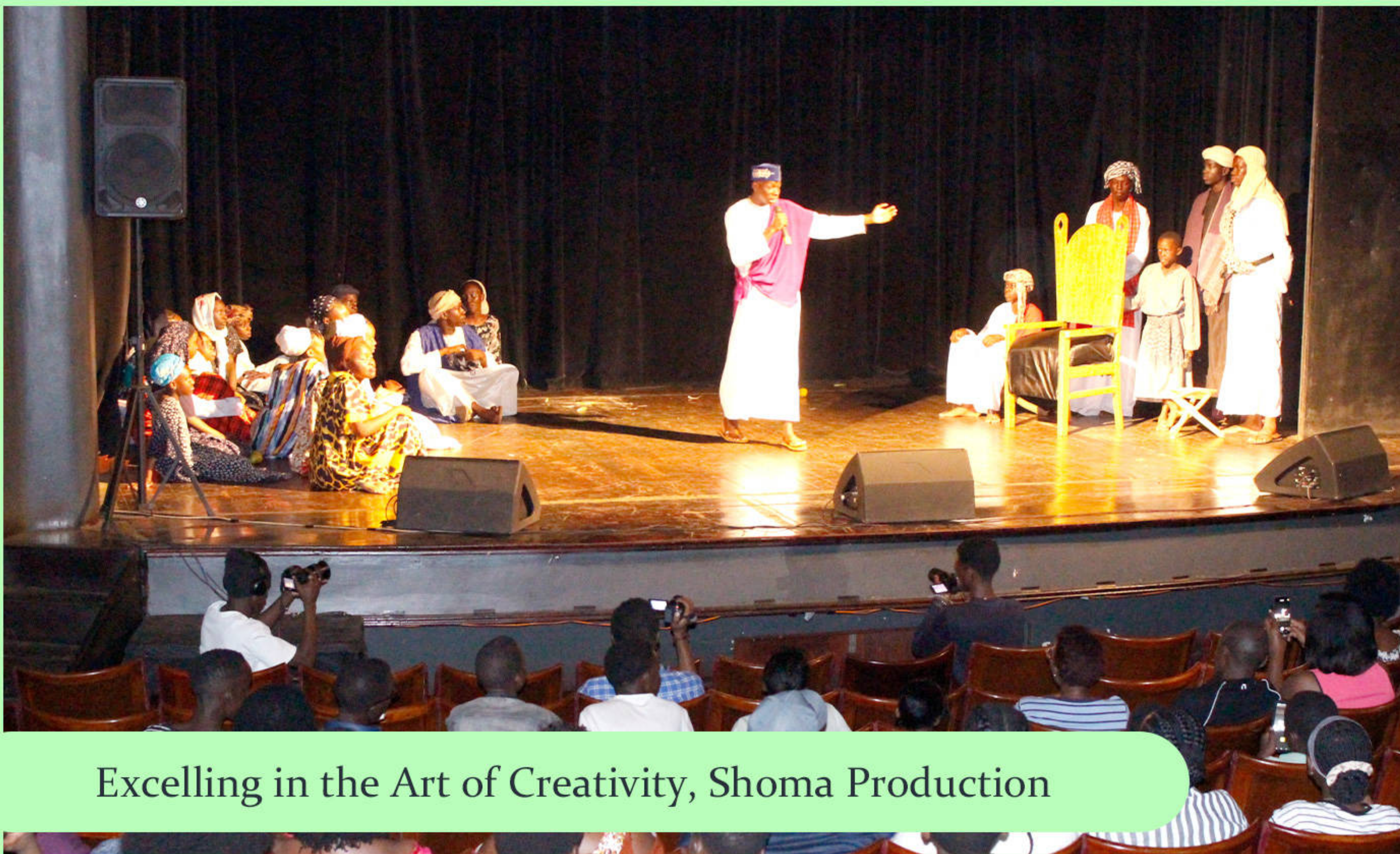

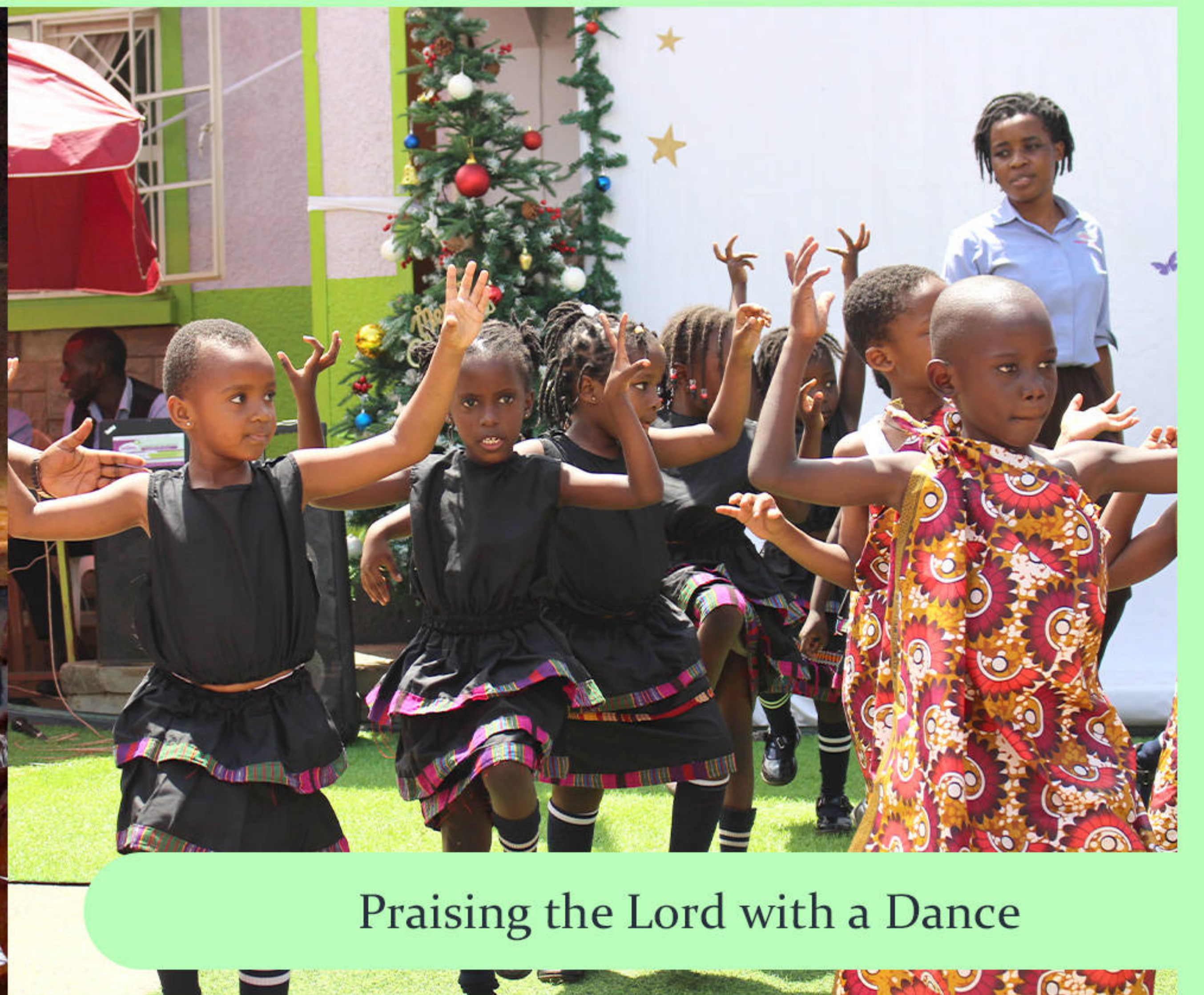

Other Fees:

1. Application / Diagnostic testing fees UGX 100,000/= for seniors, 80,000/= for Elementary students, and 60,000 for kindergarten students.

Note:

GED students are expected to pay, 300,000/ for their diagnostic tests which is included on the school fees. 2. An extra charge of UGX 34,000 per PACE will apply for PACEs above the set termly goals.

3. School Requirements must be paid in cash at the beginning of the term. Kindergarten - UGX 70,000/=, and UGX 80,000/= for Elementary and Senior students.
